We have a varied programme (see overleaf) with talks, craft sessions and outings, and we also support church activities - open days, lunches and other welcoming and community events.

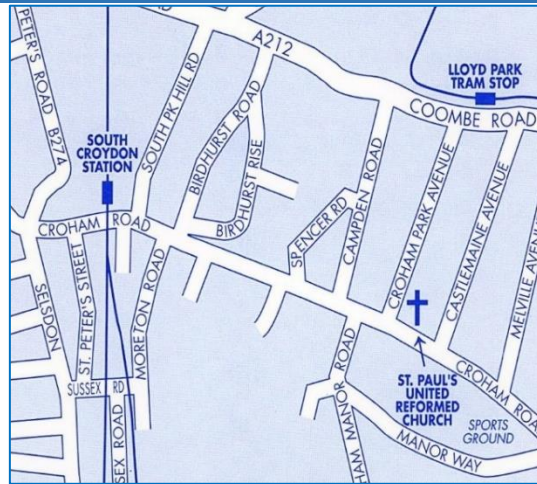


Membership of St. Paul's Guild is open to all. New members, men and women, are welcome throughout the year. The annual subscription is £15 plus a contribution for refreshments.
