We have a varied programme (see overleaf) with talks, craft sessions and outings, and we also support church activities - open days, lunches and other welcoming and community events.

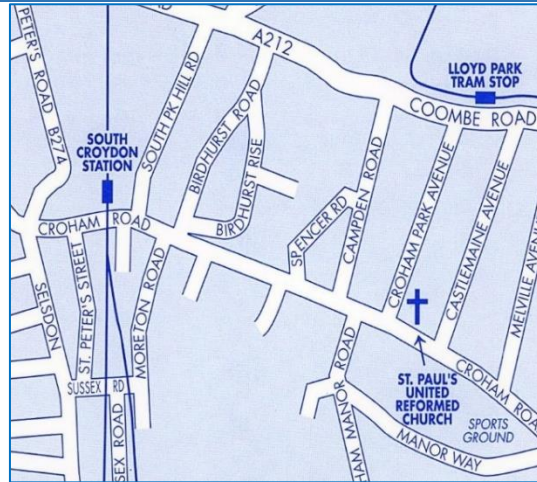
