<u>Responsive Reading using:</u> Joel 1:10-12; 2:18-29	
Left	The fields are devastated: the ground mourns.
Right	For the grain is destroyed, the wine dries up, the oil fails.
Leader	Be dismayed, you farmers, wail, you vine-dressers, over the wheat and the barley;
All	FOR THE CROPS OF THE FIELD ARE RUINED.
Leader	The vine withers, the fig tree droops. Pomegranate, palm, and apple, all the trees of the field are dried up.
All	SURELY, JOY WITHERS AWAY AMONG THE PEOPLE.
Left	Then the Lord became jealous for the land, and had pity on the people.
Right	In response to the people, the Lord said; 'I am sending you grain, wine, and oil, and you will be satisfied; and I will no more make you a mockery among the nations.'

Left	Do not fear, O soil; be glad and rejoice, for the Lord has done great things!
Right	Do not fear, you animals of the field, for the pastures of the wilderness are green.
Leader	The tree bears its fruit, the fig tree and vine give their full yield.
Left	O children of Zion, be glad and rejoice in the Lord your God.

Reading: Matthew 13:1-9 (Pg.794)


That same day Jesus went out of the house and sat beside the lake. ² Such great crowds gathered around him that he got into a boat and sat there, while the whole crowd stood on the beach. ³ And he told them many things in parables, saying: 'Listen! A sower went out to sow. ⁴ And as he sowed, some seeds fell on the path, and the birds came and ate them up. ⁵ Other seeds fell on rocky ground, where they did not have much soil, and they sprang up quickly, since they had no depth of soil. ⁶ But when the sun rose, they were scorched; and since they had no root, they withered away. ⁷ Other seeds fell among thorns, and the thorns grew up and choked them. ⁸ Other seeds fell on good soil and brought forth grain, some a hundredfold, some sixty, some thirty. ⁹ Let anyone with ears, listen!'
