Let each of you look not to your own interests, but to the interests of others. 5 Let the same mind be in you that was in Christ Jesus,

- ⁶ who, though he was in the form of God. did not regard equality with God as something to be exploited,
- ⁷ but emptied himself. taking the form of a slave. being born in human likeness.

And being found in human form,

- 8 he humbled himself and became obedient to the point of death even death on a cross.
- ⁹Therefore God also highly exalted him and gave him the name that is above every name.
- 10 so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bend. in heaven and on earth and under the earth.

¹¹ and every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

¹²Therefore, my beloved, just as you have always obeyed me, not only in my presence, but much more now in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling; ¹³ for it is God who is at work in you, enabling you both to will and to work for his good pleasure.
